

Cookies

What are cookies?

Cookies are files which contain a small amount of data from a website. These files are saved to a user's computer while browsing a website. Cookies can be used by a web server to identify users. Their use does not put the user's computer in any kind of danger; furthermore, they are usually automatically deleted after a certain period of time.

How can I disable cookies?

A user can choose to allow or disable cookies. Most web browsers automatically allow cookies – this setting can, however, be changed and use of cookies can be banned in a browser.

Information collected by Google

Google, as a third-party partner, uses cookies to display ads on the website. To display ads on the website of the operator, Google uses the “DoubleClick DART Cookie”. If a user visits a webpage with an AdSense ad, a cookie can be saved to their computer. This cookie provides information used by a website operator to display and manage AdSense ads. Google uses the DART cookies to offer website visitors relevant ads based on their browsing history.
